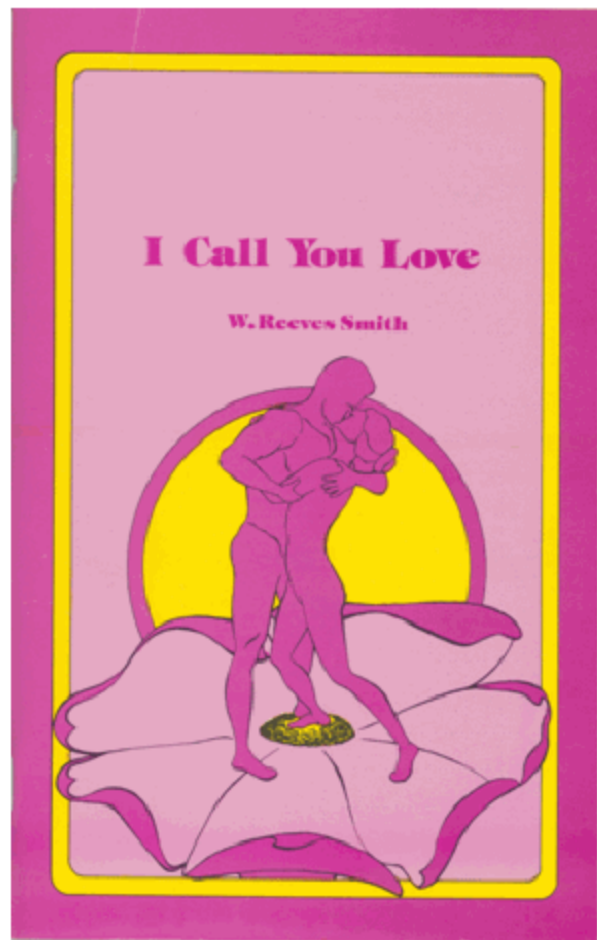


I Call You Love
